Trading Update

Kewill Systems plc ("Kewill" or "the Group"), the provider of supply chain control software and solutions, today provides an update on trading for the year ended 31 March 2006.

We are pleased to announce that full year results will be broadly in line with expectations. They are likely to show the Group has significantly increased both revenue and profits over the same period last year. However, profit before tax is likely to be marginally lower than anticipated, as revenues from large enterprise level shipping contracts (17 in the half and 29 in the year) have not fully made up for reduced revenues in the more competitive low end of the market. Interchain and Perwill, acquired during the year, have both performed well in the first few months of ownership by Kewill and have contributed strongly to the results in the second half of the year.

The Group has grown sales organically and by acquisition. Profit growth has been largely driven by the acquisitions of Interchain and Perwill, which have also increased our international trade logistics capabilities, our geographic reach and added other vertical markets.

The Group had a net cash balance of £12.9 million at 31 March 2006.

Further details of the trading performance and of the outlook will be given in the preliminary results at the beginning of June.
